ELIGIBILITY

- Only artists residing in the Interior of Alaska, Doyon Region, or be a member of the Cabin Fever Quilters Guild.
- Each artist is limited to **ONE** entry.
- The original Quilter must submit entry form (not a later recipient of the quilt).
- This exhibit is a **NON-JURIED** show. Any quilt that meets the criteria will be accepted. Work submitted must reflect the unique creative effort of the artist in use of pattern and color.
- **No kits. No copies or exact replicas of other original artwork or published quilts. No copies of any published images or copyrighted characters, i.e. Disney. Contact the Coordinator for review of any questionable quilt prior to delivery date.**
- Work must have been completed after July 2008 and not previously exhibited in the GALLERY.

Due to the gallery wall dimensions the quilts should be no more than:
96 inches (width) x 110 inches (length)
Gallery's size restrictions for the hanging wall sections are:
Quilt width for narrow wall hanging sections:
35 to 40 inches
Quilt width & length for larger wall hanging sections:
90 x 90 inches

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ENTRY FORM

Mail the completed entry form, signed by the quilter, along with a 4" x 6" personal photograph of good quality and narrative (50 words) explaining the quilt. Mail the entry form on or before June 1, 2010 to:

JUNE 1 CHECK LIST:

- _____ Completed entry form with signature.
- _____ A 4" x 6" personal photograph of good quality on good quality paper. **(NO POLAROID, NO EMAIL PHOTOS)**
- _____ A short narrative (50 words or less) **about your quilt.**

INSTRUCTIONS FOR QUILT DELIVERY

- The exhibit entry must be delivered to the BEAR GALLERY, Alaska Centennial Center for the Arts on Sunday, June 27, 2010 from 12 - 4pm.
- With the exception of wearable garments, all entries must be ready to hang with **2 inches of Velcro (hook side)** stitched firmly along the entire top of the quilt back. **Large quilts could have an additional 2" square tab of Velcro stitched to each bottom corner to aid in hanging.**
- **NO VELCRO, NO ACCEPTANCE.**
- Attach Paper Label with quilter's name and title to the back of the entry (You can find it below and to the right of this form.)
- Entry can be picked up Monday, August 2 from 12 to 4pm. No quilts will be returned by mail.
- Quilters may submit **GARMENTS OR SMALL QUILTS FOR SALE** (maximum size 25" x 25") in the Bear Gallery Gift Shop. These will be displayed in a special area as space allows. Bring these items with you on entry day or **no later than Wednesday, June 30.** Items will be checked into inventory as individual artists. **See the Office Manager or docent for inventory forms.**

CONDITIONS

- Entries must remain on display through Sunday, August 1, 2010.
- Entries will be handled with the greatest possible care and are insured against damage or loss for the duration of the exhibit. FAA is not responsible for minor wear resulting from normal handling.
- FAA retains a **25% commission on all exhibit sales.** Works will be for sale unless noted as NFS (Not for Sale). FAA retains a **35% commission on all Gift Shop Sales.** Artist's payments will be made on the 20th of the month following the exhibit's closure.
- FAA retains the right to photograph all works for documentation, publication and education.
- **SUBMITTING AN ENTRY CONSTITUTES AGREEMENT ON THE PART OF THE ARTIST TO ALL CONDITIONS IN THIS PROSPECTUS.**
