Raise Money for Charity

Everyone in our community is invited to participate as an individual or part of a team—either way, you will be raising money to support local charities. Team participants and individual walkers must raise a minimum of \$25/adult or \$15/child (6-12 years of age) if registering on or before May 6. Those registering late (after May 6) must raise \$30/adult or \$20/child.



In 2012, 50 charities received part of the \$30,546 contributed.

Charities Win!

You can designate any funds raised to the registered charity of your choice (no minimum amount required).

100% of designated funds will be donated to your chosen registered non-profit charity.

Form a Team

Find a group of walkers! The team that raises the most money by May 6 will be the first team out of the "grazing gate." Organize your team early so that they have plenty of time to secure pledges.

Individual Registrations

Funds raised from individual walkers and participants can be designated to any registered charity of their choice. The individual turning in the most money by May 6 will win a great prize!

Registration Information

Each walker must complete & sign an individual registration form either in person or online.

April 8 - May 5—Team & Individual Walker Online Registration Deadline

Register online at <http://explorefairbanks.com/charitywalk> and pay with a credit card. You can also register online to pay with cash or check. To pay with cash or check, you must pay at the bib pickup.

May 6—Bib Pickup & On-Site Registration

Noon to 7pm at the Morris Thompson Cultural and Visitors Center, 101 Dunkel Street. **All registered walkers must come to bib pickup. Walkers registered by May 6 are eligible for prizes.**

May 7-10—Late Registration

Bring form and all money raised to the Morris Thompson Cultural and Visitors Center between 9 am and 4 pm. Late registration fee of \$5 applies. You can still designate your money to one of the already registered charities. **All Walkers who register during these days are not eligible for participant prizes.**

May 10 Day of Walk—Late Registration

Bring form and all money raised to the Immaculate Conception Church Parking Lot between 4 and 6 pm. Late registration fee of \$5 applies. You can still designate your money to one of the already registered charities. **All Walkers who register during this day are not eligible for participant prizes.**
