The retreat includes breakfast and lunch, literary camaraderie and a delightful day of stimulating discussion. Daryl Farmer is the author of *Bicycling Beyond the Divide*, which received a Barnes and Noble Discover Great New Writer’s Award and was a Colorado Book Award finalist. Farmer’s work has appeared in such journals as *Paddlefish*, *Hayden’s Ferry Review*, *South Dakota Review*, *Quarter After Eight* and *Isotope*. He received his M.A. and Ph.D. in creative writing from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln and has taught at Georgia Tech. and Stephen F. Austin State University in Nacogdoches, Texas. Currently, he is an assistant professor at the University of Alaska-Fairbanks where he teaches creative writing and literature.
